A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
 - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in January or March).
 - b. The first 7 points (including the 4 described in "a") must be from LIST I and LIST II.
 - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III)
2. You may use no more than 5 courses to qualify.
3. No CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, summer school courses, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assistant, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis or through independent study.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - Grade of A = 3 CSF points.
 - Grade of B = 1 CSF point.
 - Note: One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course, up to a maximum of two such points per semester (e.g., an A in World History AP earns 4 CSF points). These classes are underlined on the back of this application.
 - Grade of C = 0 CSF points.
 - Grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

B. Also remember:

1. Semester membership is based on work done in the **previous semester**.
2. **You must reapply each semester.**
3. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS I, II and III

List the courses you are using to qualify in the proper location below. Consult the LISTS on the reverse side. As soon as you earn 10 points, you do not need to list any

 - Points from LIST I, LIST II, and LIST III must total at least ten (10).
- You may use no more than five (5) classes to qualify and no more than 2 extra points)
- CSF points are granted as follows:

A = 3 CSF points (4 CSF points if it is an AP, IB, or UC designated Honors. These courses are underlined.)
 B = 1 CSF point (2 CSF points if it is an AP, IB, or UC designated Honors. These courses are underlined.)
 C = 0 CSF points
 D or F = disqualification from membership for the current semester.
